


## Why are we here?

## Reading is a Process





### What can you do at home? Be <u>INTENTIONAL</u>

As you drive through town, note your surroundings.

Discuss what you see at the grocery store.

Ask quality questions at the dinner table each night

#### **Be An Advocate For Your Child**

- Ask questions to learn more about your child's difficulty with reading.
  - Seek resources to support his/her development.
  - Try new approaches until you find one that works for you and your child.

## Make Reading a Priority at School

Utilize additional supports offered at school.

Attend school every day.

Use resources that are sent home for your child.

Talk to your child about how important reading IS.

## Make Reading a Priority at Home

Be intentional about reading at home. Bring lots of books into the home. Read to your child. Listen to your child read. Talk about stories.

#### Establish a Reading Routine

Have a consistent schedule: set a regular time for homework and a dedicated reading time.

This should be in a quiet and comfortable environment that is free from distractions.



### Encouraging Reading Fluency

Model fluent reading for your child. This involves demonstrating smooth and expressive reading, highlighting punctuation and phrasing.

> Repeated reading builds fluency. Repetition helps improve speed, accuracy and comprehension.

#### Ask Questions

Before, during and after reading, ask open-ended questions about the text to promote critical thinking.

Ask questions that encourage discussion and deeper understanding of the text.


