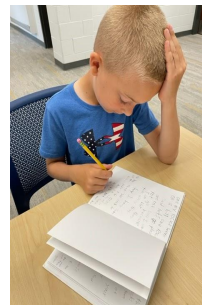

Sessions: (Current grade applies)



1. Grades K-2: Writing camp using mentor texts with a Science/Art/Nature focus. Meets June 23-27. This is a half day session. 9:00-12:00
2. Grades K-2: Writing camp using mentor texts with a Science/Art/Nature focus. Meets July 7-11. This is a half day session. 9:00-12:00
3. Grades 3-5: Tall Tales/Graphic Novel emphasis mentor texts with a community visit. Meets June 23-27. This is a full day session. 9:00-3:00
4. Grades 5-8: Harry Potter Camp. Sort into houses, then enjoy everything HP related including journals, spells, food, fantastic beasts, a game of Quidditch, and much more! Meets July 14-18.. This is a full day session. 9:00-3:00
Note: This camp cost is \$180 due to materials purchases.
